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Dear Students and Parents,

We are delighted to welcome your child to the class of 2025 at Oak Forest High School. On **Tuesday, January 19, Wednesday, January 20 and Thursday, January 21**, it is necessary for you and your child to begin enrollment and talk with our Counselors to select freshmen classes. There are 2 steps to this process.

**1. This year because of Covid, your meeting with the Counselor will be a conference call. No one will come to the school. The information you need to prepare for the call is included in this packet and listed below.**

- **Appointment schedule** – The day and time for your conference call with your Counselor is on the blue sheet enclosed in this packet. The call will last no more than 10 minutes. It is a very tight schedule, so if you are unable to be available for your appointment, please call us at 708-342-8307. The Counselor will call you. They will call the number on the blue form. If you would like them to call another number, please email [mmacke@bhsd228.com](mailto:mmacke@bhsd228.com) and provide the phone number you'd like the Counselor to call.
- **Course Request Sheet** - Review this document. It outlines the courses available to incoming freshmen. Students must take 6 courses each year. Please have this sheet handy during your call with your Counselor.
- **Curriculum Handbook** – The Handbook is provided by School District 228. The handbook provides a description of the classes offered at Oak Forest as well as other important information about graduation requirements, GPA and other student services.
- **Demographic Sheet:** Your Junior High School provided general demographic information to us. Please review the information on the Demographic sheet. Make any necessary changes and mail or email it with your residency documents. Information is provided below.
- **Health Information Packet:** This is the information you need to know about shot and physical examination requirements needed to register for the upcoming school year. Dental examinations are suggested but not required. The completed forms must be mailed or emailed to the school nurse at [cbarrins@bhsd228.com](mailto:cbarrins@bhsd228.com) by July 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- **Athletic Opportunities** – If you are considering joining or trying out for an activity, please complete this form. Coaches use this information to contact students about summer camp opportunities. Please email the completed form to [landerson@bhsd228.com](mailto:landerson@bhsd228.com)

**2. You also need to begin the registration process. Prior to the start of school, you need to prove residency. You can mail or email the documents listed below to: [ofregistration@bhsd228.com](mailto:ofregistration@bhsd228.com). At this time, no paperwork will be accepted in person.**

- Two utility bills with your name and current address
- Driver's License or State ID at current address
- Custody papers showing you have residential custody of the student
- Student's Birth Certificate
